

Project Funding Program

Rather than push things like membership incentives or “rush” programs, this year we have decided to pursue a more sustainable program that is designed to improve our membership infrastructure as a state to allow for long-term growth, while simultaneously stimulating short term growth. This program is very simple. The Grant-Hamil board has allocated \$5000 in grants for membership events for our chapters. A chapter can apply for up to \$250 in funds matching the chapter’s input into an event to help get in new members. All you have to do is fill out the form on the following page, and explain what the plan for the event is. The Executive Officer, Executive Director, and State Master Councilor will then review the submission and award the grant if the requirements are met. If the requirements aren’t, or if they see something they have a question about, they will discuss it with the chapter. The goal is to not only help chapters get in members, but also to help them develop their ability to plan events by getting feedback from new sets of eyes that may be able to provide a different viewpoint to the planning and help the event to reach it’s potential.
